

Subject: One time relaxation of attendance rule for the students of 2nd Semester of B.Sc. HHA **Programme**

Dear Principal,

This has reference to the subject cited above. It is hereby conveyed that the Chairman of BOG, NCHMCT by exercising the full power of the Board has given one time relaxation in the attendance rules for the students of 2nd Semester of B.Sc. HHA programme. This relaxation has been given after observing that the students debarred by the institutes have some confusion on the strict norms as well as the duration to complete the academic programme. Considering the fact, the Chairman of BOG, NCHMCT has approved the relaxation of attendance rule for the new JNU batch, being the first batch. Therefore, all the detainee students in Term-end examination of 2nd Semester of B.Sc. HHA now be allowed to sit in the examination from tomorrow onwards. If necessary, the practical examinations may be conducted suitably after the completion of Term-end examination for such detained students if not allowed to sit in the practical examinations as per original schedule.

It may be noted that this is a one time relaxation only by considering the confusion arisen in the minds of the students being with the first time with JNU. As such, a written undertaking should be obtained from the students that such short attendance will not be repeated by them in any subsequent semesters during the entire tenure of study and such undertaking should also be endorsed by their parents.

Therefore, all the institutes are hereby instructed to communicate about the above relaxation to all the detained students and allow them to sit in the Term-end examination from tomorrow onwards as stated above. A report about the action taken on the above said instruction should be sent to NCHMCT by tomorrow afternoon positively.
